Statement

This certificate provides for the carrying out of bushfire hazard reduction work on the specified property. All work must be carried out in a manner consistent with the approved treatment options and must comply with all the specified conditions.

Conditions

Carrying out of work

1. All bushfire hazard reduction work must be carried out in accordance with:
- The Blue Mountains Bushfire Risk Management Plan; and
 - The Bushfire Environmental Assessment Code 2006; and
 - Blue Mountains City Council Bushfire Hazard Reduction Standards.

Environmental

2. All works are to be undertaken in accordance with the attached document *Specification for Prescribed Burns (July 2008)*

Threatened species

3. The burn plan must include measures to minimise the impacts on nearby threatened species (*Microstrobos fitzgeraldii* and *Leionema lachnaeoides*) should the fire escape containment lines.

Cultural heritage

4. No items of cultural heritage significance are known to exist on this site

Use of fire

5. If approval has been granted for the use of fire, the certificate holder must:
- Comply with NSW Rural Fire Service standards for Pile Burning and the standards for Low Intensity Bushfire Hazard Reduction Burning. Copies are available from www.rfs.nsw.gov.au
 - Provide a minimum of 1 working day's notice the Blue Mountains Rural Fire Service on 4782 2159 or, if the land on which the fire is to be lit is in a NSW Fire Brigade District, the officer in charge of the fire station nearest the land.

6. This certificate holder is required to comply with any applicable 'no burn' notices issued by Environmental Protection Authority, Department of Environment & Conservation.

Separate application

7. If approval has been granted for the use of fire in a declared bushfire danger period, the certificate holder must also obtain a fire safety permit.
These can available from the Blue Mountains Rural Fire Service or NSW Fire Brigades.

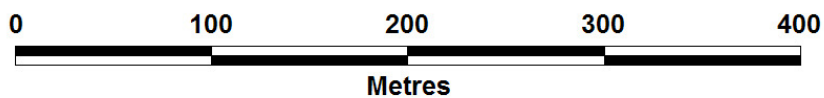
